- 1 CAMRIS** works closely with agencies such as USAID, the DoD, VA, and CDC, currently implementing approximately \$130 million in global support contracts.
- 2 CAMRIS** is the prime contractor on the new Global Health Support Initiative II (GHSI-II), a \$79 million project (2010-2013) providing up to 90 senior program and technical experts to support USAID's global health activities worldwide.
- 3 CAMRIS** has completed more than 200 initiatives in more than 50 countries under the USAID Global Health Technical Assistance Project (GH Tech).
